Getting there

From the airport

Bus

The best way to get here from the airport is to take the **Aircoach** - blue bus, orange writing - c 12 euro return. These buses collect just outside each terminal, but there are a few routes...

You will need to get a particular one though.... here is the one to get:

To go to the office directly.... get out at **The School House stop**. We are 4 min walk from there almost in the direction that you came from.... just check it out on google maps.

It takes about 20 mins from terminal 2 at airport to the office.

Car

If you are coming from the airport you can go through the Tunnel and the East Link Toll Bridge. Depending on the time of day there are different charges. Up to 10 am, the fee is 10 EUR for the tunnel and 3 EUR after that. So probably come that way if you need to get to the office early or really quickly. (20 Mins)

Coming through the city will take at least 25 mins, and more depending on the time of day,

NOTE: You cannot get access by car from the Pearse Street side of Clanwilliam Terrace, you must come from Grand Canal Street Lower/Upper side.

Parking

There is parking at the office, but please check beforehand as the spaces may already be allocated for the day. Once you arrive onto Clanwilliam Terrace (cobblestone road), head towards the bridge at the end, and half way down the street there is a laneway to the left. Take the laneway to the car park, go down the ramp towards the underground parking. The last three parking spaces before the first pillar on the left are allocated to us.

Taxi

Taxis can use the bus routes, and this can save a lot of time during rush hour. From Dublin Airport, the fee will be about 26 EUR

From the City

I suggest that you walk or take a taxi. We are 12 min walk from the bottom of Grafton Street.

Dart Station: The Grand Canal Dock station is the nearest. And about a 4 min walk from there.

Staying there

Hotels

Search around there are plenty of hotels etc. - the prices quoted can have huge variances on different sites (hotels.com etc.), and it really depends upon your price range and if you are collecting your points, and what else is in town at the time.

<5 min walk

The Grand Canal Hotel is the nearest and can be reasonably priced but nothing too fancy.


If you are looking for a hotel - have a look at the Clayton Hotel on Macken street/Cardiff Lane
